MEDFIELD FOUNDATION RAISES MONIES FOR ZULLO GALLERY

Medfield, MA – The Medfield Foundation delivered to Bill Pope of the Zullo Gallery the proceeds received from the Medfield Foundation’s most recent quarterly fund raiser, that focused on the Zullo Gallery. The Medfield Foundation’s check was presented by its treasurer, Abby Marble to the Zullo Gallery’s Bill Pope, with Medfield Foundation board member Osler Peterson looking on.

The Zullo Gallery (www.zullogallery.org) is Medfield’s nonprofit art gallery, located on the 2nd floor at 456A Main Street, that began in 1988 as a project of the Medfield Council On The Arts. The Zullo Gallery provides high quality art exhibits throughout the year, and annually features a fall juried exhibit open to all artists and a spring student / faculty exhibit of art by Medfield school students and art faculty. The gallery is open 12-5 every Saturday and Sunday, and has current plans for a coffee house with expanded hours.

Abby Marble stated that this Medfield Foundation quarterly fund raiser for the Zullo Gallery “is exactly the sort of public and private partnership that the Medfield Foundation was created to fulfill, raising private funds for unmet public needs in Medfield.” She noted that the Medfield Foundation (www.MedfieldFoundation.org) also has assisted the Council on Aging to raise funds for its bus, the Medfield Youth Outreach Worker for the unmet needs of Medfield youth, and the individuals building a new Dale Street School playground (close to \$100,000 already raised). The Medfield Foundation is a private nonprofit, tax deductible corporation created in 2002 to raises private monies for public purposes in Medfield. The Medfield Foundation allows donors to designate their donations for particular purposes. The Medfield Foundation also allows groups to raise monies for Medfield purposes via the umbrella of the Medfield Foundation.
