MEDFIELD FOUNDATION SEEKS NOTEBOOK COMPUTER

Medfield, MA – The Medfield Foundation needs a notebook computer for its volunteers to use to document and record its many fund raising activities, and is asking the community whether anyone has an extra notebook computer that can be donated. The Medfield Foundation has been so successful in assisting people in town raise private monies for public purposes that the Medfield Foundation is fast becoming a victim of its own successes, and needs more tools to assist in the record keeping that the success has created. The notebook will be loaded with the software that runs the Medfield Foundation, and used only by the Medfield Foundation volunteers to track and record Medfield Foundation transactions.

The Medfield Foundation is a volunteer run private nonprofit, tax deductible 501(c)(3) corporation created in 2001 to raises private monies for public purposes in Medfield. The Medfield Foundation allows donors to designate their donations for particular purposes. The Medfield Foundation also allows groups to raise monies for Medfield purposes via the umbrella of the Medfield Foundation.

To date the Medfield Foundation has raised and administered private donations to help fund the senior bus, the fireworks, the Dale Street Playground, the Medfield High School field, the Domeshek Library Fund, the MYCC, the town's Youth Outreach Worker, the Zullo Gallery, the Adult Community Center, the new Medfield High School auditorium, the schools in general, and the Animal Shelter.

Abby Marble, Medfield Foundation's treasurer and Cindy Hern, its volunteer attorney would be the initial users of the notebook. Cindy said, "The notebook would allow us to load and store all of our records and software in one central location, but also allow us to pass the computer back and forth as each of us had the time to work on Medfield Foundation business. The notebook would effectively become the Medfield Foundation's virtual office."
